Recycling Fact



How many plastic bags are thrown away each year in the US?

100 billion plastic bags

In a landfill, these single-use bags will take up to 1,000 years to

degrade. According to The Wall Street Journal, the U.S. goes through 100 billion plastic shopping bags annually. An estimated 12 million barrels of oil is required to make that many plastic bags. Four out of five grocery bags in the US are now plastic!

Did you know that 94% of tap water in the United States is contaminated with microscopic plastic fibers?
